Town of Cary Board Meeting

Unapproved Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 6:10 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance and Prayer led by Chairman Mark Gosh. In attendance were: Chairman Gosh, Supervisors Dale Zawislan and Dennis Brunner, Treasurer Carey Rucker, and Clerk Jean Gansch. Two town residents were also in attendance.

Checks were reviewed and signed.

Minutes of the June 8, 2021 meeting were read and approved, **motion** by Dale Zawislan, and seconded by Dennis Brunner was made and passed.

**Public Input:** Mr. Jacobson requested gravel from contractor Ladick, at the price that the town gets it. This has been a past practice in the township. Discussion continued. Chairman Gosh will contact Ladick and see if this is still possible. Gravel from Ladick is \$12.82/yard, and from Bugar is \$12.22/yard.

Dale Zawislan suggested that the wording in next year's bid include residents be able to buy gravel at the same price as the town.

**New Business:**

- Town of Rock Chair was supposed to attend this meeting to discuss border road policy, but he was not present.
- Access road on Accola's field south of the town hall property, the board and Mr. Accola discussed the best ways to complete this project; ditching, culvert, rock base.
- Mr. Accola may consider donating the land north of the town hall to the highway to the Town of Cary, not sell. He estimates the amount of land is 1/3 to 1/2 acre. Ms. Rucker brought up the possibility that the land would have to be surveyed. Chairman Gosh had some suggestions for the use for the land including landscaping, veteran's memorial, installing a flag pole, a sign visible from the highway to indicate the town hall.
- ARPA funds: The first half of the distribution was deposited in the Town's account in the Associated Bank. The board will continue to examine the regulations regarding the areas allowed to use this money.
- Discussion was held on possible revenue generation for town hall improvements.

**Old Business:**

- Board reported that gravel was spread on Steffic Road
- Ditch cutting by Shawn Dupee, Mr. Dupee had some equipment problems and the job has not been completed. He indicated he would not bid for the job again next year. His equipment is not appropriate for the task at hand. Board discussed purchasing our own equipment, but after much discussion it was decided that this is not a good idea at this time. The issue will be tabled for the time being.
- Culvert problem on Cary Rock Road west of County V: This is still an ongoing problem. The water is still standing in the field, and has no drainage. Ditching the field is still an option for the owner.
- Letter from Jeff Yetter concerning the culvert on Yetter Road was read by Clerk indicating Mr. Yetter does not wish to install a culvert at this time, so Mr. Ecker can begin cleaning out the ditch to increase water flow on that corner.

**Clerk Information:** Clerk reported the voice recorder was purchased.

**Treasurer's Information:**

- Treasurer's Report was reviewed, **motion** to accept Treasurer's Report was made by Dale Zawislan and seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion passed.
- Ms. Rucker reported that Quick Books on line was not available for our use, the township is not 503c, therefore we will have to purchase the program for about \$400. We can load it onto a computer at the town hall and both the Clerk and Treasurer will be able to input data. Mr. Jacobson said that he has a large monitor screen that he is willing to donate to the town for this use. Chairman Gosh stated that the laptop computer assigned to him would also be available for this use. **Motion** made by Dale Zawislan to purchase Quick Books, seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion passed.
