Pledge of Allegiance

Prayer: Led by Chairman Gosh

Present: Mark Gosh, Chairman, Dale Zawislan and Dennis Brunner, Supervisors; Carey Rucker, Treasurer; Jean Gansch, Clerk; Three residents.

Review and Sign Checks:

Minutes of Last Meeting: Minutes were read and approved—Motion made by Dale Zawislan and seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion passed.

Treasurer's report was given by Carey Rucker—Motion to accept treasurer's report by Dennis Brunner and seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion passed.

Public Input: Jean Strack asked about the ditch mowing in the township. Discussion followed. Chairman Gosh reported that he had tried to contact JJ for ditch mowing, but was not able to connect with them yet. He will continue to work on this issue. If JJ does not respond Chair will contact Poncratz to complete the job.

New Business: Dupee Construction Bill—Chairman Gosh talked with Shawn Dupee about his bill, Dupee agreed to accept one half of the billed amount of \$2,600 = \$1,300. This amount will be paid this month.

Budget discussion: Board discussed the progress from the August 13th meeting of the Town Board. Supervisor Brunner asked about the Fire protection contract for the upcoming year. Clerk will report on that.

Mr. Patrick suggested that the COVID relief fund might be used to bring internet access to the Town Hall.

Kafka Surface Preparation—Magnesium Chloride was spread on the four miles of new gravel, and the four miles of last year's gravel, plus the intersections, hills, and other areas deemed necessary.

Culvert policy was discussed, Clerk will provide documents on current policy and board will discuss at next meeting.

Crack filling on Steffek Road was completed this year. Chairman Gosh notified residents that there was work being done to the road, Solutions did the work, more to be completed weather permitting.

Road report: There were some trees down on Sparks Road due to storms. Chairman Gosh and Supervisor Zawislan cleared the road and patrolled the roads for more possible hazards.

Old Business: Letter to Town's People—no action at this time. Riding lawn mower purchase was discussed, the price of a new mower verses getting a used mower were options. The purchase of a new mower is not an urgent need at this time, because Supervisor Zawislan indicated that he was willing to continue mowing the lawn.

Clerk Information: Clerk presented the contract with Insight FS for next year's heating fuel (propane). The contract was signed and Clerk will mail it back to Insight.

Treasurer's Information: The town has received the new tax-exempt number; copies were distributed to Board members for purchasing for the town. Treasurer Rucker discussed changing our Budget Codes for easier bookkeeping.

The upcoming WTA Workshop on September 17th will be attended by Clerk Gansch, Treasurer Rucker, Chairman Gosh, and Supervisor Zawislan. The use of the Education Fund for those attending the workshop was discussed.
