

Town of Cary Monthly Board Meeting October 8, 2018 unapproved

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Cary Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Cary Town Hall by Chairman Jim Patrick after The Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Jim Patrick Chairman, Supervisors Dennis Brunner & Mark Yetter, Treasurer Barb Schmidt and Clerk Pat Lippert. Also present Tim Ecker grader man and two taxpayer.

Mark made a motion to accept the minutes, Dennis seconded, motion passed.

Mark made a motion to accept the treasurer report Dennis seconded, motion passed.

Old Business: Taxpayer called and asked about his driveway etc. Chairman said he would schedule him for a meeting with the town board. He did not show up at the October meeting. Mark and Dennis attended the Southwest County Recycling Board Meeting. They found that we would have to give them a year's notice to leave the group. Further information will be looked into and discuss at the next meeting. . The board is still looking for the original contract.

Document shredder is now in use for town documents when applicable.

New post and signs were installed at Lindsey and Steffek Road

Garbage bin was purchased from Country Disposal. Vendor will not charge town for garbage pickup from the town hall.

Roads: Gravel work is completed on Yetter, Lindsey and Johnson. **Fahrner** completed work on Steffek and Cary Rock Oct 5th 2018. Gravel is completed on all roads in the Town of Cary cost approx. \$18000 dollars. **JJ'S** Brush Cutting Service will do the 4th cut this month on the brush in the road right of way.

Road signs replacement Almost all the signs in the township failed inspection, both for readability and reflectivity. Chairman said he would like to order some with the money left in the highway budget. Dennis made a motion, Mark seconded, motion passed. The town board will make their own post pounder so as not to wreck the top of the poles. They also discussed buying grader blades and 1 culvert 36 inch x 20 feet.

Dennis made a motion and Mark seconded to sign the contract for the Pittsville Fire and Ambulance, motion passed. The price was emergency medical \$25,210.64, fire was \$44,118.62

Computer purchase of laptops for the clerk and treasurer use was discussed to be included in the 2019 budget. With license agreement they would cost \$650-700 each. They will go with the office as the personal change. Board members will check out different prices and be discussed at next meeting.

Chairman discussed attending the Wisconsin Towns Association Meeting at Stevens Point Oct 14-16th.

Dennis made a motion to pay bills and Mark seconded, motion passed. Checks written out were # 9097 to 9111 for the amount of \$20,899.97 Next meeting will be Thursday November 15, 2018 at 7:00 pm. at the Cary Town Hall 5688 Accola Road. Included will be Special Meeting of Electors, adopt the 2019 levy, Town Board adopt the budget and regular monthly meeting.

Dennis made a motion to adjourn and Mark seconded, motion passed. Meeting ended at 8:30 p.m. Patricia Lippert Clerk
