Ordinance 001 – 2020

The Town Board of the Town of Cary, Wood County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under s.7.30 (1), Wisconsin Statutes, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of two (or more) sets of officials to work at different times on each election day, as follows:

There may be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 A. M. and end at 1:45 P. M. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 P. M. and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.


The Chief Inspector shall be on duty the entire day from 6:30 A. M. until the completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.


