Minutes of Regular Town Board Meeting

Budget Hearing

Call to order at 6:00 PM on November 17, 2022. Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and a prayer was given. Present were board members: Chairman Mark Gosh, Supervisors Dennis Brunner and Dale Zawislan, Treasurer Carey Rucker, Clerk Jean Gansch, and Deputy Clerk Lori Hiebl. One member of the town was also present. The public proposed no changes to the proposed 2023 Budget for the Town of Cary. Motion to adjourn was made by Dennis Brunner, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion passed. Meeting was adjourned at 6:20 PM

Regular Monthly Board Meeting

The regular monthly town board meeting was called to order at 6:20 PM. Present were board members: Chairman Mark Gosh, Supervisors Dennis Brunner and Dale Zawislan, Treasurer Carey Rucker, Clerk Jean Gansch, and Deputy Clerk Lori Hiebl. One member of the town was also present.

Checks were reviewed and signed.

Minutes of the October 11, 2022 meeting were read and a motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Dale Zawislan and seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion passed.

Clerk presented two culvert permits to be signed by board members.

A letter from the Town Board to be included with the Tax Bills was discussed, possible inclusions were: upcoming elections, locations of the posting signs in the township, and a note from the Chairman. Also, the need for updated garbage and recycling calendars was brought up. Treasurer will contact the vendors for more information.

Type A Notice for April, 2023 Election was discussed. It needs to be posted now.

Treasurer's Report was reviewed (we are balanced through July and we will continue to work on balancing through the end of the year) and a motion was made to accept and file the report as given, (with the addition that ARPA fund balance would be shown on following reports) motion to file was made by Dennis Brunner and seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion passed.

New Business: Motion to Adopt the 2023 Budget was made by Dennis Brunner and seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion passed, by voice vote (three) 3 to (zero) 0.

The town board will host annual Christmas party again this year. The date is set for December 13th, 2022, following the regular December Town Board Meeting.

Old Business: Chairman Gosh signed the Fire and Ambulance contracts with the Pittsville Fire Department on November 1st.

Next Town Board Meeting will be on December 13, 2022 at 6:00 PM; with the Holiday Party to follow.
