New Business: A caucus will be held on January 10th 2023 at 6pm to choose the next applicants for Chairman and Supervisors I and II positions that are up for election April 2023. Regular meeting to follow. EL-162 needs to be filled out by each person wanting to fill the positions listed. Those forms can be given to Jean Gansch.

Appointment of Clerk and Treasurer was also brought up as far as how long their terms will be, Dale Zawislan said it needs to be for a minimum of 6 months to a max of 3 years. Also, to be discussed were wages and if a contract will need to be drawn up.

Discussion of future business was tabled

Old Business: Questions for Rural Insurance – what are the requirements for liability if we hire another fire service. Registration was discussed for the upcoming WTA District Meeting in February in Marshfield.

Road update by Tim Ecker: Turner Road was all torn up. All other roads are in good winter shape.
