On April 10th, 2024 the Town Board of Cary met at the Town Hall at 8:00 AM. The meeting was called to order, Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and a Prayer was given. In attendance were: Chairman Mark Gosh, Supervisors Dennis Brunner and Dale Zawislan, and Road and Building Superintendent Tim Ecker.

Discussion was held on overhead door replacement and construction to fix the opening for door installation. Results: after presentation and discussion with Road and Building Superintendent the following decisions were made: 2-doors 1—14′ X 12′ Insulated 13.9 R-Value, and 1—12′ X 12′ Insulated 13.9 R-Value; 2-Openers; Items to be purchased from Menards for \$6,358.00 with openers.

Estimated approximately \$300.00 tin and gaskets and lumber

With labor total cost of \$9,958.00.

First check to be written to Menard's for \$6,000.00

Second check for \$4,000.00 written to Tim Ecker for labor and Materials. Tim will have an insured helper to assist and pay. Tim will also keep the 11% rebate from Menard's as part of his labor.

Motion made by Dennis Brunner and seconded by Dale Zawislan to purchase material and pay labor of \$10,000.00 to Tim Ecker. Motion passed.

Road Inspection Report

Accola Road—Hwy 73 South is good to Cook Road, Accola from Cook South needs granite.

Cook Road—West from Accola needs granite for 2025 season. Cook Road East from Accola is good. There has been some recent ditching done on South side. North side on Lippert farm needs ditching work.

Cary Hiles Road—from B to Wolf Road 3-4 condition good.

Wolf Road—3-4 good

Yetter Road—from Wolf East good 3-4

Turner Road—good until the top of hill South, this needs granite and repair. Town will advise Wood Township of repairs.

Yetter Road—from Wolf Road to Hwy 73 (3-4 good), Hwy 73 to Dupee's Construction needs granite—25 loads

Amelia Road—condition 2-3 needs granite next 2 years. For 2024 needs one load of granite at Amelia and Intersection with B.

Steffek Road—Crack fill blacktop possibly by 2025

Johnson Road—South of Steffek needs granite for 1 ½ mile south, project for summer of 2024.

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Johnson Road—North of Steffek is being engineered for asphalt at this time projected for summer of 2024.

Steffek Road—from Johnson Road West to curve needs granite 50 loads.

Wussow Road—passable and okay for now

Steffek Road to Lindsey Road, 3-4 good

Steffek Road—County V to Dead End has Bugar Material, good

Lindsey road—from Steffek North to V needs granite scheduled 2025 Lindsey Highway 73-ksparks 50 Loads

Cary Rock—West of V maintained by Rock Township

Cary Rock Road—from County V East to B—out part gravel is good, #4 Asphalt is still very good. Above tree branches need trim on Asphalt part of road.

Dabrowski Lane—3-4 good condition

Eastlane-passable

Progress Road—from Hwy 73 North to Sparks is 3-4 good

Sparks Road—West to County V needs granite

Sparks Road—West of County V is good to Messing Lane

Dickson Lane—There is a culvert request, 15" is recommended, road is passable

Granite Recommendations for 2024

Put out bids to usual Suppliers for 2,340 yards of decomposed (crushed) granite.
