Annual Meeting for the Town of Cary was called to order at 6:00 Pm on April 15, 2025 by Chairman Mark Gosh. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a prayer was given.

Verification of Public Notice: Notice was posted on Town's website, and the three posting boxes within the township. All board members present and one citizen.

The minutes of the Annual Meeting from April 16, 2024 were read and a motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

The date for next year's annual meeting was set for the Third Tuesday of April in 2026—the 21<sup>st</sup>, motion made by Dale Zawislan and seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Chairman reviewed ruled on what can and cannot be decided upon at an Annual Meeting.

Propose raise for Town Supervisors—motion to raise town supervisors' salary from \$100 per month to \$150 per month was made by Lori Hiebl and seconded by Carey Rucker, motion carried by unanimous voice vote. (Starting the following month)

Discussion was held on the possible need to increase Levey Limit for this upcoming tax year, due to increasing costs of road work and other expenses. This will be revisited during budget planning this coming fall.

The Financial Report was presented for review, motion was made to accept the Financial Report as presented by Dennis Brunner and seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

The Chairman reported that the annual road inspection took place on April 9th, and the Supervisors and Maintenance Supervisor took a tour of the concerning roads within the township, highlighting bridges, culverts, and rough spots that will need attention this year. The bridge on Steffek—1st bridge East of County V, Cary Rock Road needs crack sealing, possible blacktopping of Robin West to top of hill, approximately ¾ of a mile.

Motion to donate \$200 to Pittsville Historical Society, and \$100 to the Clark County Humane Society was made by Lori Hiebl, seconded by Carey Rucker, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Motion to renew Wisconsin Town's Association membership at a cost of \$823.76 was made by Carey Rucker and seconded by Lori Hiebl, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

No further Public Input.
