July 8, 2025
Town Board Meeting Minutes
(Unofficial)

The regular monthly meeting of the Cary Town Board was called to order at 6:00 PM, on July 8, 2025. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a prayer was given. Present were the board members: Mark Gosh, Dennis Brunner, Dale Zawislan, Carey Rucker, Jean Gansch, and Lori Hiebl, also in attendance were one community member and Thresa Pankratz.

Checks were reviewed and signed.

Minutes of the June 10th meeting was read and a motion to approve the minutes was made by Dennis Brunner, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried.

Clerk reported that the proposed Insight/FS contract was here and discussion was held on whether to go with Option 1—prepay program, or Option 2—Pay as you go. A difference of \$.10/gallon of LP fuel. Mark will investigate further.

Reminder that the WTA Unit Meeting is on July 18th hosted by the Town of Seneca at the Nekoosa Community Center.

Ms. Pankratz discussed the gravel delivery of the past month to the township, and asked if the board had any questions of her. Mark thanked her for her time and effort and stated that the town may want further loads of gravel dependent on budget constraints.

Treasurer's Report was given by Carey Rucker, she informed the board that money would need to be transferred from one bank to the one we use for paying bills, they discussed closing out the extra accounts. Motion to file Treasurer's Report was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion carried.

Public Input—Mowing the ditches was brought up by JS. She was concerned about the length of the grass and some places looked like they had not been mowed.

Roads—would like to be able to discuss current conditions with TE. Will make decision on whether to have more gravel delivered to other roads at next meeting. Dust control is being considered for some township roads.

Furnace update—a new furnace would cost about \$4600-\$4900. Discussed getting an alarm or alert system for the thermostat to call one of the board members if the temp falls below a certain degree. Carey will investigate alert systems and get back to the board.

Motion to adjourn made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Dennis Brunner, motion carried. Meeting ended at 7:15 PM.
