The regular monthly meeting of the Cary Town Board was called to order at 6:00 p.m., on August 12th, 2025. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and a prayer was given. Present were board members: Mark Gosh, Dennis Brunner, Dale Zawislan, Carey Rucker, Jean Gansch, and Lori Hiebl; also, in attendance were 7 members of the community.

Checks were reviewed and signed.

Minutes of the July 8th, 2025 meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes was made by Dennis Brunner and seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried.

It was a discount of \$.10 over what was offered in the initial contract negotiation. The mower had to have some major repairs this past month.

Old Business—Traffic Counter on Cary Rock Road has been picked up. Dust control was ordered through the county and should be delivered sometime this week on Yetter Road and the roads that new gravel was laid.

Road Report--Tim is trying to get ditches mowed and roads graded.
