Town Board Meeting
February 10, 2026

The regular Town Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on February 10, 2026. The pledge of Allegiance was recited and a prayer was given. Clerk's report: The county will be purchasing a new tabulating machine that will replace the DS200 with model DS300, the cost to the township will be \$1,000, this is to inform townships so they can budget for this in the coming year. WTA email about Small Structure grant availability for bridges was shared. Culvert Permit was presented for approval. 2026 WTA Fall Convention to be held in Stevens Point in early October. The regular WTA Wood County Unit meeting will be held on February 20th at the Pittsville, Community Center—Mark, Dale and Dennis will attend.
