Town Board Meeting
March 10, 2026

The regular Town Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on March 10, 2026. The pledge of Allegiance was recited and a prayer was given. Present were board members: Dennis Brunner, Dale Zawislan, Carey Rucker, Jean Gansch, and Lori Hiebl. Dale Zawislan chaired the meeting. One member of the community was also present.

Checks were reviewed and signed. Minutes of the February 10, 2026 meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes was made by Dennis Brunner, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried. Discussion on a monitoring thermostat for the shop furnace was held. Carey will investigate this for more information.

Clerk's Report—Fire dues report was submitted. A letter from DOR about tax assessment was referenced, Gerald Wegner has also received a copy of this letter. TDS sent an email about the proposed utility installation in the township. Lori brought up a concern about suspicious activity around the townhall recently. She will check the camera footage to see if anything was caught on it.

Treasurer's Report—It takes two signatures to close the account at First State Bank, Carey and Jean will coordinate to get that done. Dennis Brunner made a motion to file the Treasurer's Report, Dale Zawislan seconded the motion, motion passed.
