Town Board Meeting  
April 21, 2026

The regular Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. on April 21, 2026. The pledge of Allegiance was recited and a prayer was given. Present were board members: Mark Gosh, Dale Zawislan, Carey Rucker, Jean Gansch, and Lori Hiebl. This meeting followed the Annual Meeting.

The Chairman rearranged the order of Agenda. Checks were signed at the end of the meeting.

A moment of silence was observed in remembrance of Dennis Brunner. He served the Town Board for more than 15 years, and he passed away suddenly this past month.

Appointment of replacement to fill Dennis' role as Supervisor I, a motion to appoint Jeff Ignatowski to fulfill this seat was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Mark Gosh, motion passed by voice vote. The Oath of Office was administered by the clerk—Jean Gansch.

Minutes of the March 10<sup>th</sup> 2026 meeting were read, motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Jeff Ignatowski, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried.

Brief discussion on the Enbridge application for their used pickup truck, other townships that have applied are Arpin and Siegel.

Treasurer's Report, current balances and expenditures were reviewed. Motion to file Treasurer's report was made by Jeff Ignatowski, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried.
