The regular meeting of the Cary Town Board was called to order at 5:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and a prayer was given. Present were board members: Mark Gosh, Jeff Ignatowski, and Dale Zawislan.

Motion by Jeff Ignatowski, second by Dale Zawislan to adjourn to closed session per Wisconsin State Statute 19.85(1)(c) "Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility." Annual Employee Review Roll call: All ayes. Motion carried. (Time: 5:00 p.m.)

Motion by Jeff Ignatowski, seconded by Dale Zawislan to return to open session. Roll call: All ayes. Motion carried. (Time: 6:00 p.m.)

Dust Control: To be spread on Yetter Road, and as a binder on newly spread gravel throughout the township. Also, on intersections, and on Lindsey Road at designated places. Board will look into who has the best prices, and order accordingly.

Crack Repair on Cary Rock Road: The county does this for time and materials.

Public Notice of Bids for Double Chip Seal on Steffek Road Repair will be posted according to state statute. (Must be posted for 2 consecutive weeks-with the last 7 days prior to Public Meeting)

Rural Insurance representative sent word that he is available to answer all board questions with just a phone call.

Assessor's Report: Jerry Wegner was present to inform the board of the ongoing assessment of the township and the progress he is making.

Public input: There was an incident on Truner Road last Sunday with noticeable damage to the road caused by reckless use of ATVs. A culvert needs to be replaced on Johnson Road, the culvert failed and there was road damage.

Board of Review: Formal BOR will not proceed until assessment is complete and will adjourn until assessment is complete. This will take place 30 days after Open Book (the date to be determined at a later date).
