Town Board Meeting Minutes
June 9, 2026

The monthly meeting of the Cary Town Board was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on June 9, 2026. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a Prayer was given. Present were Town Board Members: Mark Gosh, Dale Zawislan, Jeff Ignatowski, Carey Rucker, Jean Gansch, and Lori Hiebl. Also, Present were: Theresa Ponkratz, and 5 members of the community.

Review and Sign Checks—Theresa Ponkratz collected her check for delivered gravel and she departed. All other checks were reviewed and signed.

Minutes of the May 12th, 2026; motion was made by Jeff Ignatowski and seconded by Dale Zawislan to waive the reading of the minutes and accept them as presented (With one spelling error corrected.) Motion carried.

Clerk's Report—An IT Strategies Group, LLC contacted the clerk and asked to share information about cyber security, after discussion it was decided to reject their offer. Motion to accept Clerk's Report was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Jeff Ignatowski, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report—The account at First State Bank was officially closed and the money that was withdrawn was deposited in the account at Forward Bank. Balances were presented and an updated Expenditures of Budget was presented. Motion to file Treasurer's Report was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Jeff Ignatowski, motion carried.

Public Input—A member of the community brought up concerns he had about ATV traffic on Town Roads. He asked that Speed Limit Signs be posted. Dale will look into this matter. Also discussed was garbage in the ditches along the town's roads. We are not a zoned township and have no way to enforce policing of untidy properties. Citizens are not allowed to place impediments in the roadway, may cause a hazard to traffic. Citizen was also concerned about a ditch situation causing flooding on his property, Jeff will inspect with grader operator, and make advisement to the board.

Old Business—Discussion on Plow truck, motion to keep the plow truck as is was made by Jeff Ignatowski, seconded by Mark Gosh, motion carried. Operator will look into purchasing a rust inhibitor to coat vulnerable areas to prevent more rust on the truck.

Dust Control—dust control (Sodium Chloride) will be purchased and spread on newly graveled surfaces throughout the township.

New Business—Assessor's Report submitted by Jerry Wegner was discussed, no date for Open Book or Board of Review has been set due to needing a completed assessment.

Revised Culvert Ordinance—Motion to accept the revised Culvert Ordinance-001-2026, was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Jeff Ignatowski, motion carried.

Pankratz delivered required gravel to roads designated by the board.

Next meeting will be July 14, 2026

Motion to adjourn was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Jeff Ignatowski, motion carried.
