Town Board Meeting
September 16, 2026

The Special Monthly meeting of the Cary Town Board was called to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a prayer was given. Present were board members: Chairman Mark Gosh, Supervisors Jeff Ignatowski and Dale Zawislan, Treasurer Carey Rucker, Clerk Jean Gansch, and Deputy Clerk Lori Hiebl. One member of the community was also present.

Minutes of the August 13th meeting were read, motion to approve the minutes was made by Jeff Ignatowski, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried. Minutes of the September 8th meeting were read, motion to approve (with one correction) was made by Jeff Ignatowski, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried.

Clerk's Report—Two new Election Inspectors are proposed to be approved at the next monthly meeting, motion to put this on the agenda for next month made by Jeff Ignatowski, seconded by Dale Zawislan, motion carried. Proposed Dust Control Survey post cards were brought to the board's attention; one was approved and will be included with the tax bills.

Treasurer's Report—Carey reviewed current balances in checking and savings accounts, as well as income received and deposited. Motion to file Treasurer's Report was made by Dale Zawislan, seconded by Jeff Ignatowski, motion carried. Treasurer clarified that check signing authorization rests with Treasurer, Clerk, and Chair.

Town Board Resolution Supporting A Comprehensive and Sustainable Transportation Funding Solution—Resolution No. 2026-02 was read and reviewed. Status of Shop Furnace—Jeff talked to a local handyman, who explained that the heat exchanger was cracked due to incorrect ventilation. A new furnace could cost \$5200.00, board will continue to investigate with other companies for more pricing options.

Status of Town's Plow Truck—Done with painting, greased fittings, need to get pump off of Sander, O-rings are leaking, Need parts from Trucking Company

Dale inquired with Rural Insurance about reimbursement on glass replacement.
